

Please follow this alternate STEP 1 instead of the STEP 1 on the instruction sheet included with the Manta® Latch.

STEP 1

- Mark the *SIDE* of the gate post with a horizontal line at the desired height of the latch handle. Use of a level is recommended.
- Place the template so the "triangular locating notch" is centered on the line and the template label is on the *FRONT* side as shown.
- Using a pencil, mark the holes labeled "FRONT" as well as the center hole on the template label side (for the handle spindle).
- Reverse the template so that the "triangular locating notch" is still located on the line but the template label is on the *BACK* side.
- Using a pencil, mark the holes labeled "BACK" as well as the center hole on the template label side (for the handle spindle).
- Drill a ϕ 5/8" hole at the center mark (handle spindle location) on the *FRONT* and *BACK* of the gate.
- Drill small pilot holes, ϕ 1/8" MAX at each of the remaining hole locations.
- Proceed to STEP 2 of the instructions included with the Manta® Latch.

TAKE CARE TO ENSURE THAT THE HOLES ARE STRAIGHT AND LEVEL
